33rd IARIW General Conference, Rotterdam, the Netherlands, August 24-30, 2014

Preparations for our 33rd IARIW General Conference, which is taking place in Rotterdam, the Netherlands, August 24-30 are almost complete. Thanks to the great work done by the local organizer, Statistics Netherlands, this conference will be a very memorable experience. We start with the "walk around" dinner on Sunday evening in the impressive De Doelen conference centre and end with the farewell dinner on Friday evening in a former distillery. All persons registered will have received an information sheet on conference activities from Statistics Netherlands.

The opening plenary session of the conference will feature two distinguished keynote speakers. Bart van Ark, Chief Economist at The Conference Board, will address the issue of measuring and monitoring the world economy since the financial crisis. Paul Schnabel, Professor at Utrecht University and former Director of the Netherlands Institute for Social Research, will speak on well-being in the post-welfare state society.

Conference delegates are reminded that it is the discussants who both present and discuss the papers at IARIW General Conferences. This means that authors of papers do not have to prepare PowerPoint presentations for their papers.

On-line Availability of Conference Papers

It has long been an IARIW tradition to distribute papers before the conference to allow participants the opportunity to read them before the event. It is believed that this availability improves the quality of the discussion at the conference. The internet now allows us to make papers available before the conference not just to those attending the conference, but to all members, and indeed to the general public.

The new Canadian Charities Act has required the updating of the Association's by-laws. The proposed new set of by-laws is posted at <u>http://www.iariw.org/IARIWBy-lawNo.1.pdf</u>. The most important change to the by-laws is the reduction in the term of Council members from six years to four years. Starting with the 2016 Council election, four persons will be elected to a term of four years, in contrast to the current three persons elected to a term of six years. The new by-laws will need approval at the membership meeting.

Session Proposals for the 2016 General Conference

Members are reminded that session proposals for the 34th IARIW General Conference, which will take place in Germany in August 2016, are now being received by the secretariat (<u>info@iariw.org</u>) and will continue to be received until noon on Tuesday, August 26. These proposals will be distributed and discussed at the membership meeting.

IARIW-OECD Conference on the SNA in 2015

Building on the success of recent special conferences, the IARIW is planning two special conferences for 2015. The first, co-organized in collaboration with the OECD is entitled "W(h)ither the National Accounts?" It will take place at the OECD Conference Centre in Paris, April 16-17, 2015.
