IARIW 2015 Special Conferences

In non-General Conference years the IARIW organizes conferences on specialized topics. In 2013, the IARIW organized two special conferences. The first, in partnership with IBGE, the Brazilian central statistical office, was on income and wealth issues related to Latin America. The conference was held in Rio de Janeiro in September 2013. The second, in partnership with the University of New South Wales, was on productivity issues. This conference was held in Sydney, Australia in November 2013. Special issues of the *Review of Income and Wealth* based on selected papers from the conferences are currently being prepared.

The IARIW is planning two special conferences for 2015. The first, in partnership with the OECD, is entitled "W(h)ither the SNA?" and will be held in Paris in April 16-17, 2015. The call for papers is posted at http://iariw.org/call2015.pdf. The second, currently under discussion with CAMPAS, the Egyptian national statistical office, will be on income and wealth issues in the Arab world and is provisionally planned for Cairo in late 2015.
