#### 2010 IARIW General Conference

The 2010 General Conference of the International Association for Research in Income and Wealth (IARIW) will take place in St. Gallen, Switzerland, August 22-28, 2010. The preliminary conference program is now posted at <a href="http://www.iariw.org/c2010.php">http://www.iariw.org/c2010.php</a> and will be published in the March 2010 issue of the Review of Income and Wealth. The conference website hosted by the conference co-organizer, the Swiss Federal Statistical Office, will include details on the accommodation packages and registration. The membership will be notified as soon as this website is operational.

On September 14, 2009, President Sarkozy of France released the report of the Commission on the Measurement of Economic Performance and Social Progress. This seminal report has important implications for the work of statistical agencies and consequently is of great interest to the IARIW membership. I am pleased to announce that the opening plenary session at the conference will be devoted to the report, with presentations by members of the Commission and senior officials from central statistical agencies.

Following on the success of the training session on national accounts at the 2008 General Conference, this year's conference will feature two training sessions, one on national accounts and a second on microsimulation modeling. The sessions will take place on August 21 and 22 immediately preceding the conference. There is no fee for IARIW members. Details on the sessions will be available shortly.

### 2009 IARIW Special Conference on Measuring the Informal Sector
